Dear Mr. President and First Lady:

Knowing of your personal commitment to strong pro-life and pro-family values, I write to you from Puerto Rico about a serious matter at the CEPAL meeting this week in San Juan.

Countries are being pressured to unequivocally reaffirm previous documents from the CEPAL population meeting in Santiago last March, and this month's meeting in Mexico. These documents contain direct attacks on the right to life, family rights and national sovereignty. I am enclosing a critique to briefly explain these concerns.

I urge you to consider instructing your delegation NOT to reaffirm these problem areas in the Santiago or Mexico documents because of these concerns.
